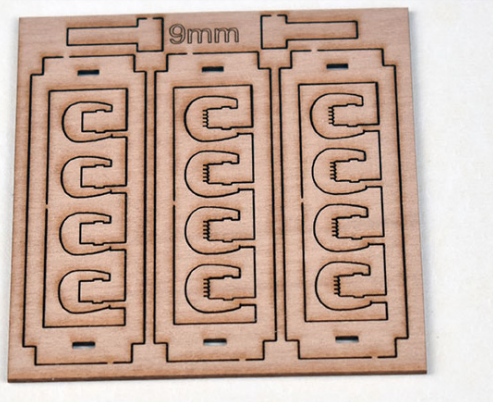
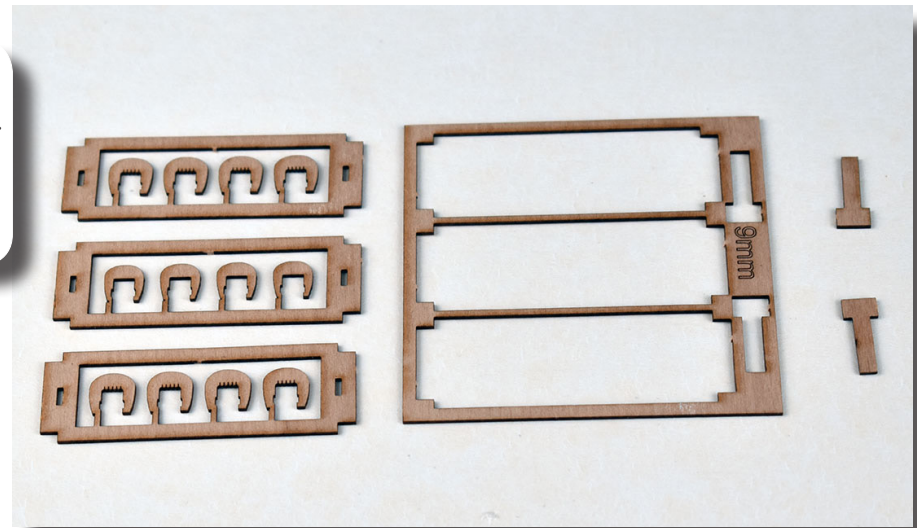


Open and closed heart block assembly

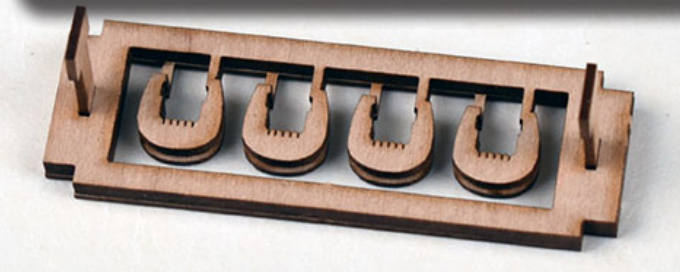


Remove the three layers from their frame, including the two location 'T' shaped pegs, and also remove the inner excess so you are left with what you see on the right hand picture



Above - Sandwich the three layers together (Above shows two layers, waiting for the third to be applied on top), making sure the smallest layer is in the centre, and the two larger outer layers have their laser engraved lanyard lines facing outward, not inward towards the centre layer.

Below - Apply a small drop of PVA wood glue to both sides of the middle layer of blocks, and when all three are together, insert the alignment keys as shown.



Right - The three layers are now glued and aligned with the keys. Once the glue has cured, remove each block from its frame by cutting off the tabs and then file or sand the ends flush. The blocks can now be used or finished further by filing or sanding the edges to give the blocks a more rounded appearance. This method of assembly applied to all sizes of both open and closed heart blocks.
